

LOCAL RULES

1. OUT OF BOUNDS (RULE 18.2)

- Beyond any wall, fence or line of white posts bounding the course.
- Beyond the Swilcan Burn on the right of the 1st hole and beyond the stakes on the right of the 1st and 2nd holes.
- Beyond the fence behind the 18th green and 1st tee and on or over the white line between sections of this fence.

NOTE: The posts on the right of the 12th & 13th holes do not define a boundary on the Old Course and are Immovable Obstructions (Rule 16.1 applies).

2. PENALTY AREAS (RULE 17.1)

- Those parts of the Swilcan Burn which are marked with yellow stakes are yellow penalty areas.
- Those parts of the Swilcan Burn which are marked with red stakes are red penalty areas.

3. ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS (RULE 16.1)

(a) Ground Under Repair

Any areas marked as Ground Under Repair and/or surrounded by a white line.

(b) Immovable Obstructions

- To include march stones and the white stakes to the right of the 12th and 13th holes which define a boundary for the Eden Course only.
- All artificially surfaced roads and paths with the exception of the road crossing the 1st and 18th holes and the road and path behind the 17th green from the two black and yellow posts onwards.

4. INTEGRAL OBJECTS

The road crossing the 1st and 18th holes and the road and path behind the 17th green from the two black and yellow posts onwards are integral objects and the ball must be played as it lies or declared unplayable.

5. BUNKERS (RULE 12)

Stones in bunker - before playing a ball in a bunker, a player may remove loose impediments under Rule 12.2a.

6. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS CLOSE TO PUTTING GREEN

Relief from interference by an immovable obstruction may be taken under Rule 16.1. The player also has these extra options to take relief when such immovable obstructions are close to the putting green and on the line of play:

Ball in General Area. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b

if an immovable obstruction is:

On the line of play, and is:

- Within two club-lengths of the putting green, and
- Within two club-lengths of the ball.

Exception - No Relief If Line of Play Clearly Unreasonable.

There is no relief under this Local Rule if the player chooses a line of play that is clearly unreasonable.

Penalty for Playing Ball from a Wrong Place in Breach of Local Rule 6: General Penalty Under Rule 14.7a.
